


Get started guide for authors submitting an article for P-LRT, Volume 5, Issue 2 (Ver. 1.1)








You will receive a submission confirmation email from the system. The paper will undergo review, and conference organizers will get back to you with review comments/decisions.


Once your article has been accepted, you will receive an email from METEOR.




Then, please log in to METEOR and click "My Tasks" to find your task "Submit Final Manuscript."



Click on "Submit Final Manuscript" to get the window below. As instructed at the beginning of this page, first delete any old and unnecessary versions of files already uploaded by clicking on the trash icons on their right, then drag/drop the final version of your manuscript and upload it by clicking on the "Upload files" button! (STEP 1)



If necessary, please read and write comments (STEP 2).
